If you have not paid your dues, you will need to pay \$205.00 for each year (\$180 dues plus \$25 late fee) in order to receive a pool tag. You can pay by check made out to BQR HOA or by exact cash. Reminder about commercial vehicles and all trailers.

Any commercial vehicle, truck, or trailer that is not being actively loaded or unloaded cannot be parked on the street in front of your house. This is a violation of OKC municipal code 59-10450 and the BQR Covenants (4.2).

In addition, it is a violation of the BQR Covenants to park any trailer (commercial or personal) in front of your house or in your driveway. Please abide by these rules and keep our neighborhood safe and looking nice.

Keep Our Neighborhood Safe and Beautiful!

The Board members have received complaints about dogs — dog waste in yards not being cleaned up by owners; and dogs not being under control and biting other dogs walking down the street on a leash with owner. Please respect your neighbors and clean up after your pet if he/she leaves a present in someone's yard. There have even been "presents" left in the public area by the pavilion and playground — this presents a health hazard to our children who play there.

Please keep your dogs contained at all times, even if on your property. This is from the City of OKC website regarding dogs:

In the City of Oklahoma City, dogs must be kept on a leash at all times outside of their home. This ordinance is in effect not only for the safety of the dogs, but the safety of other citizens as well. All dogs are also required to wear their rabies tags at all times, and the ordinance requires owners to dispose of pet waste when the pet is off their own property. If you would like to report a loose dog in your neighborhood, call OKC Animal Welfare at 297-3100. Please give the address where the dog lives, where it is roaming loose and what type of dog it is.

Another complaint is speeding cars; and drivers failing to stop at stop signs. A reminder - the speed limit in the neighborhood is 25 mph. Please, for the safety of each other and especially our precious children, please slow down.
